Reidsville resident Arnold Robertson, in a surprise presentation at the April 9, 2019 Reidsville City Council meeting, received the State's highest honor for civilians, the Order of the Long Leaf Pine.

Councilman James Festerman, a fellow recipient, presented the honor on behalf of Governor Roy Cooper.
