GREENVIEW CEMETERY PATRONS**

The 2018 mowing season is about to begin. The Public Works Department of the City of Reidsville would like to thank all patrons for their interest and support in keeping Greenview Cemetery a place where we can be proud of while honoring our deceased loved ones.

We ask your help and cooperation during the mowing season in keeping the grounds free of things that interfere with the mowing process. Please observe the following requirements;

1. Flowers shall not be placed on the ground during the mowing season. Flowers may be attached to headstones, be placed in headstone mounted vases or in flat marker mounted vases.
2. Borders of stone, brick, wooden timbers, etc., around any grave(s) are strictly prohibited.
3. Items such as glass vases, jars, figurines, lights, shepherd's hooks, etc., are not permitted
4. Metal or wooden stakes or posts driven into the ground are prohibited.
5. Planting of flowers, shrubbery, trees, etc., is prohibited.
6. Families wanting to save flowers, wreaths, potted plants, etc., should remove them from individual graves within thirty (30) days following funeral services.
7. All prohibited items shall be removed by city staff without notice. Any such materials removed from cemetery grounds will be placed near the cemetery shop.
