**REIDSVILLE'S FALL JUBILEE**

Each October, thousands of residents and visitors take the opportunity to see how Reidsville embodies their city slogan — *Live Simply; Think Big* — at the city's annual Fall Jubilee. The 27<sup>th</sup> annual festival is set for Saturday, October 20, from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. Admission to the downtown festival is free.

The Fall Jubilee is one of the largest festivals in Rockingham County and draws thousands of people from across North Carolina and southern Virginia for entertainment, food, fun and a car show. The show, featuring more than 200 beautifully restored antique cars and trucks, street rods and classics, is sponsored by the EZ Street Cruisers Car Club. This car show is always a highlight of the festival and the car show circuit, and is one of the largest in the Southeast.

The Reidsville Fall Jubilee will showcase more than 100 quality vendors offering a mix of art, crafts, jewelry, fashion accessories, pottery, home and garden décor, and much more. Visitors will also find favorite fun festival foods, including turkey legs, hot dogs, barbecue, blooming onions, funnel cakes, snow cones, steak and cheese sandwiches, ribs, and sausage dogs — to name a few.

Building on Reidsville's claim as "North Carolina's High School Football Capital," Festival visitors will be encouraged to visit and shop in local downtown businesses to fill a "Playbook." Participants will collect stickers from merchants to be entered in prize drawings, and redeem receipts from downtown businesses for bonus gifts. Details will be available at the Information Tent near Market Square.

The Kidz Zone features bounce houses and amusement rides, and will include *Touch A Truck* with vehicles from the city's Police, Fire, and Public Works departments. Captain Jim's Magic Shack will open for shows at 11 a.m. and 1, 3, and 5 p.m.

Music will be presented all day, with groups alternating between stages at Market Square and Scales/Morehead. Entertainment includes:

**10-11:30 a.m.: UTurnband** (Christian Rock) @Market Square

Local Christian Pop / Rock band UTurn will open the Fall Jubilee!

**11:30 a.m.-1 p.m.: Big Bang Boom** (Parent-Friendly Children's Rock) @Scales/Morehead

Big Bang Boom is a pop/rock music group from Greensboro that plays parent-friendly children's music. After 20 years touring clubs and playing parties, Chuck Folds (younger brother of Ben Folds), Steve Willard, and Eddie Walker decided to expand their horizons and play for parents who have had enough of Barney, The Wiggles, and Kidz Bop. Big Bang Boom is kid's music with a pop sensibility, aimed at being something that parents can enjoy and feel good about letting their kids listen to and see live.

**1-2:30 p.m.: The Clanky Lincolns** (Funk / Pop / Rock) @Market Square
