CodeRED Message from Mayor Jay Donecker Regarding COVID-19

Hello Reidsville citizens, this is Mayor Jay Donecker calling you with our weekly COVID-19 update. At the end of last week, Rockingham County is reported to have at least 40 positive testing results for COVID-19. This is an increase of 11 during one week so please continue to take precautions to prevent its spread.

The Governor has issued a new Executive Order for the State to begin Phase 1 of the Reopening of North Carolina. The significant changes under this phase are:

- Citizens can leave home for commercial activity.
- Retail establishments can increase from 20% to 50% capacity.
- Childcare centers can open for those working or seeking work.

There are three important W's to know if you leave your home:

- Wear a cloth face covering
- Wait 6 feet apart and avoid close contact.
- Wash your hands often or use hand sanitizer.

I want to thank you for your individual focus on these three W's. We have made Reidsville "Neighbor Safe" and recognize a balance needs to be struck between our community health and our economic health so we continue to stay "Reidsville Neighbor Safe". It may seem like an inconvenience to wear a mask when around others but to many of our loved ones, it could be a lifesayer.

The City will continue its COVID-19 Pandemic operational responses enacted prior to Phase 1 of the State's reopening. Your City government remains available to serve our citizens so please do not hesitate to call or schedule an appointment.
