



# Community Clean Up scheduled on May 4

The Reidsville Appearance Commission wants you to “Toss It for Reidsville.”

Trash, that is, into garbage bags. The Commission is looking for volunteers to meet behind Reidsville City Hall, 230 West Morehead Street, on Saturday, May 4, 2019, for a Community Litter Pick Up day. RAC members and the public will meet at 9 a.m. and then go to their designated cleanup sites.

Donna Setliff, the City of Reidsville’s Community Development Manager and staff liaison to the RAC, explains that the recommended locations are inspected the week beforehand and put on a list of collection sites. Volunteers need only bring their gloves, she added, noting that safety vests and trash bags will be provided.

The annual event will be cancelled if it rains. Cancellation of the event will be posted on the City of Reidsville’s Facebook page early Saturday morning.

The RAC is dedicated to beautifying the City of Reidsville and keeping it clean. This community cleanup day has been an annual event for many years.

This year the City of Reidsville joined with other municipalities in the County to approve a Resolution Supporting a Zero Tolerance for Litter in Rockingham County. The City will also provide a member to the newly formed Litter Prevention Advisory Committee established by Rockingham County government.
